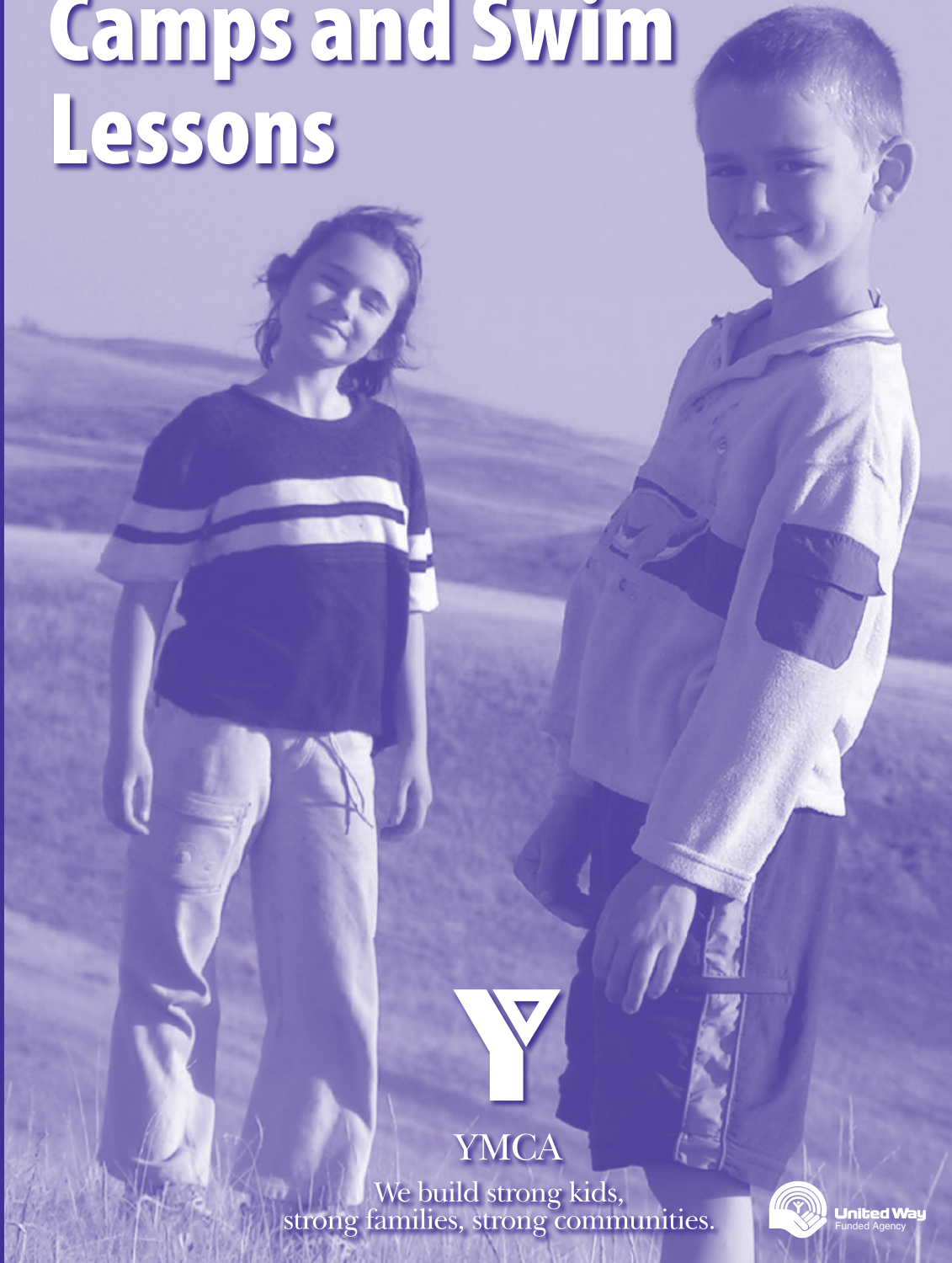

YMCA DAY CAMP Located at Blackstrap Lake Ages 5 – 12

No camps offered August 1, 2011

This day camp offers a unique out of city camping experience with the advantage of returning home each night.

Activities include: canoeing, kayaking, archery, environmental education, survival skills, initiative tasks, wide games, arts & crafts, hiking, sing alongs, skits, swimming and water games! All waterfront activities are supervised by a certified lifeguard. Family night provides an opportunity for parents/guardians and siblings to join us for a tour, hot dogs and a campfire program. The evening starts at 5:15 pm and the bus leaves at 6:15 pm.

Before and after camp care are provided at the YMCA only starting at 7:30 AM and ending at 6:00 PM.

There is no cost for using before and after camp care.

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT) LEADERSHIP CAMP
